

WHAT IS PEI ASSET MANAGEMENT DOING TO FACE COVID-19?

Following several weeks of the Mandatory Preventative Isolation ordered by the National Government, Pei Asset Management continues to carry out a series of actions to face the challenges posed by this situation and contribute to its different stakeholders' well-being.





THE ASSETS:

After the National Government allowed certain of the country's economic sectors activation, the portfolio assets continue to apply preventive measures aimed at guaranteeing its workers' and visitors' health, following the World Health Organization- WHO' guidelines:

Corporate Assets:

Minimum two meters-distance between visitors, occupants, and administrative staff.

Logistics and Industrial Assets:

■ Temperature control and alert on evident symptoms. Persons with evident symptoms are not allowed access to the assets.

Commercial Assets:

- Distancing within the parking and unloading areas.
- People's counting and control at the entrances, to avoid crowds in the different areas of the properties.
- Installation of personal protection elements.
- Digital shifts were installed in the food courts, for the foods' dispatch.
- The cleaning brigades of the common areas were intensified.

Assets under development:

- Receipt of any elements cannot be by hand. Any and all elements must be transported in disinfected vehicles.
- Workers must preferably have their own work tools; if such tools are of common use, they must be disinfected before and after their use.
- Entry and exit times were established for staff control purposes.

Pei Asset Management will also continue to permanently assist the tenants and monitor their businesses' evolution, while the final plan for the assets' reopening is established.



WORKERS FIRST:

Management Committee: a group of directors is in charge of assessing the situation's evolution. These Committee receives, examines, and manages the main audiences' needs and concerns.

Work-From-Home: each team received all the necessary tools to carry out their daily tasks, with the Management Committee's and area leaders' support.
